We have plans to close the Day Shelter for cleaning 1/12 – 1/16. The Shelter will reopen on 1/17. This is an historic time because the Shelter has never closed since its inception in 1985 (a testament to our dedication!). With COVID-19 an imminent risk, it is time we close the Shelter for only five days to thoroughly clean, sanitize, and disinfect the entire facility. The building's exterior and interiors are in need of a deep clean. With continued, ongoing, and ever-changing directives from the Department of Health and Governor's Office, it is critical now more than ever that our Day Shelter is thoroughly cleaned, so we can do our part to mitigate any community spread and keep our clients and staff safe.
