We provide resources, opportunities, and hope those experiencing or at risk of experiencing homelessness.

Our Vision:

We aim to end homelessness, one person, and one family at a time

About Us:

HopeWorks is the largest nonprofit organization in New Mexico working to end homelessness among individuals and families. Every year, approximately 15,000 men, women, and children come through our doors, seeking services to help them exit their homeless episode. Hope is a powerful word, and combined with Works, our name signifies a new beginning for our clients, but one that requires thoughtful, deliberate action. Our clients take an active role in becoming independent and self-sufficient. We give them the tools to live the life they deserve, but they must always remain hopeful that a tide will turn, a barrier will fall. Light is at the end of the tunnel.

History:

We are 501(c)(3), community-based nonprofit organization. Founded in 1985 by a group of concerned leaders, HopeWorks has grown to become the largest provider of services for people experiencing (or at risk of) homelessness in New Mexico. Every year, approximately 15,000 individuals come to us for help.

Key Programs - *HopeWorks is more than a homeless shelter*

- **Day Shelter and Basic Needs:** Food, clothing, storage, showers, mail, IDs, resources for over 8,000 individuals/year.
- **Outreach:** Outreach encounters over 1,000 individuals living on the streets, tunnels, tents, and alleyways. to them (as well as getting them housed).
- **Housing:** HopeWorks permanently houses over 400 people a year.
- **Behavioral/Mental Health:** We provide intensive case management, coordinating medical, housing, and psychiatric services, medications, and psychiatry for over 800 individuals.
- **Employment:** Through various programs, including our social enterprise we place almost 2,000 people in jobs/year.

In 2020...

119,647 meals served to hungry families and individuals.

300 people were placed into permanent jobs and stability.

Over **450** people have received housing assistance.

1,300 people were encountered by our Outreach Team who provided information, basic needs care, and resources.

HopeWorks offered more than **15** unique behavioral health programs. from substance treatment to outpatient therapy, we provided services to over **800** individuals.
